a. College Website

Appreciating the formation of e-governance cell, Prof. H. S. Nagendraswamy, suggested further fine tuning the information available on the website. The Professor was very particular about the language part and suggested correcting typographical errors that would have inadvertently crept in.

While approving the admissions the members commented on the sets of combinations offered by college and Prof. S. N. Vikram Raje Urs enquired on the relationship between subjects like Chemistry and Biotechnology.

The Principal explained that in the preceding years combination like Botany, Chemistry, Biotechnology (BCBt) was offered and under the NEP scheme, the old combination was split into Botany – Chemistry, Botany – Biotechnology and Chemistry – Biotechnology combinations. The Principal directed the HoDs of Chemistry and Biotechnology to explain the correlation between the two disciplines.

The HoD of Chemistry explained that the two disciplines were interdependent and mutually helped each other in understanding the key concepts. The HoD of Biotechnology explained that Chemistry formed the basic foundation to understand bio analytical techniques in Biotechnology and explained that Chemistry would supplement the studies in advanced techniques in Biotechnology. The member was convinced with the explanations and later the Academic Council gave approval to the Admissions for the academic year 2021-22.

Noticing poor admissions to the Arts combinations, the honorable members unanimously suggested corresponding with the University and reducing the sanctioned strength from the present 90 to 40 in Arts combinations.

By doing so the “low admissions to the Arts combinations would not be reflected pathetically in the table”, they observed. The other members expressed similar opinion and recommended reducing the sanctioned intake.

Suggestion regarding reducing the sanctioned strength was noted

The Academic Council congratulated the successful students and gave its approval to the results.

30.6 Implementation of NEP

Observing Principal’s presentation on the Implementation of NEP, Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna instructed that all the members of faculty should be aware of the rules and regulations governing the NEP. ‘only then the teachers could convince the students’, he suggested. He further commented that while offering combinations under NEP, the college should seriously think of

proposing **innovative combinations** which could be useful to students. “Otherwise” he observed ‘there was no point in going ahead with NEP’.

Supplementing the observation Dr. K. S. Rajashekara, pointed out that there was a need to break the wall between the subjects and make the education interdisciplinary.

The Academic Council, gave its consent to the suggestion.

Regarding flexibility in framing the syllabus, Dr. Rechanna observed that there was a specific regulation that even autonomous colleges could only make 20% changes in the syllabus proposed by the University of Mysore. The Principal informed that such a binding was issued to avoid the problem of mobility among the students.

The Academic Council, at length discussed the freedom of autonomous college in framing their own syllabi under NEP.

Regarding structural changes in the higher education under NEP, Prof. Nagendra Swamy, suggested introducing Research Methodology in the last semester of Honors Programme as it would create not only an awareness on Research but also enable students to take up Ph.D soon after completing Honors Degree.

Suggestions regarding implementation of NEP and introducing a paper on Research Methodology were noted.

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

Noticing that the results of First semester, under NEP have not yet been announced, Prof. Nagendra Swamy, recommended to bring it to the notice of the University of Mysore, and follow the guidelines of the University, governing the policy of NEP. The members further observed that the results of Third semester, have also not being announced because of technical problem, wanted to know the exact reason.


