- Preparation, Consideration and Recommendation of NEP 2020 BA Syllabus in Journalism and Mass Communication (UG) as per the UGC Norms.
- 4. In BOS Meeting members approved and recommended the UG Syllabus on NEP pattern for BA – Journalism and Mass Communication, Scheme of Examination, Question paper pattern as a cognate subject in UG for implementation in the colleges affiliated to the University of Mysore, during academic year 2022-23.
- Miscellaneous subject like Practical's, Field Work, Internship, Media Fest were also discussed by the board.
- The marks for practical papers that is DSC were earlier allotted as 20 marks for practical record and 30 marks for theory. However, the marks have now been modified according to the university norms as 25 marks for practical record and 25 marks for theory.
- Earlier the open elective papers had practical component. However, the practical
 component has been removed as per the university norms. 60 marks have been allotted to
 theory and 40 marks have been allotted to internal assessment.
