

Scholarship Guidelines

The College encourages students to pursue higher education by providing information and support regarding various scholarships and financial assistance schemes offered by the Government, University, and other recognized organizations.

1. Eligibility

Students may apply for scholarships based on the eligibility criteria prescribed by the respective scholarship authority. Eligibility may depend on factors such as:

- Academic performance and attendance.
- Annual family income.
- Category/community, wherever applicable.
- Domicile or residential status.
- Disability status, wherever applicable.
- Course and year of study.
- Other conditions specified by the respective scholarship scheme.

2. Application Procedure

- Students should regularly check the College scholarship notice board and official communication channels for scholarship notifications.
- Eligible students should register on the concerned scholarship portal, wherever online application is required.
- Students must complete the application form carefully and within the prescribed deadline.
- All required documents must be uploaded/submitted as specified by the scholarship authority.
- Students should retain a copy of the submitted application and acknowledgement for future reference.

3. Documents Generally Required

Depending on the scholarship scheme, students may be required to submit:

- Aadhaar Card or other valid identity proof.
- Student ID/College admission details.
- Previous academic marks card.

- Income Certificate.
- Caste/Community Certificate, wherever applicable.
- Domicile/Residence Certificate, wherever applicable.
- Disability Certificate, wherever applicable.
- Bank account details/passbook.
- Passport-size photograph.
- Other documents prescribed by the scholarship authority.

4. Verification

- The College will verify the scholarship applications and supporting documents as required.
- Students are responsible for providing accurate and genuine information.
- Applications containing incorrect, incomplete, or misleading information may be rejected.
- The College may seek additional documents or clarification during the verification process.

5. Scholarship Disbursement

Scholarship amounts are generally disbursed by the concerned Government department, University, or scholarship authority according to its rules and schedule. The College does not guarantee the sanction or amount of any scholarship.

Students should ensure that their bank account details are correct and active to facilitate direct transfer of scholarship benefits, wherever applicable.

6. Responsibilities of Students

Students are expected to:

- Apply before the prescribed deadline.
- Provide accurate information and valid documents.
- Maintain the required academic performance and attendance.
- Respond promptly to requests for clarification or additional documents.
- Track the status of their scholarship application.
- Inform the College of any change in personal, academic, or bank details.

7. Important Note

Scholarship eligibility, application procedures, deadlines, and benefits are subject to the rules and notifications issued by the respective scholarship authorities from time to time. Students are advised to refer to the official scholarship portal and College notifications for the latest information.

Scholarship Support

The College facilitates and guides eligible students in the scholarship application and verification process. Students may contact the Scholarship Section/College Office for assistance regarding application procedures, document verification, and other scholarship-related queries.
